We ask that you follow the CDC and Minnesota Department of Health guidelines, when entering the City of Scanlon buildings, please wear a mask.

**ELECTION:** Election will be open to Scanlon residents in the Scanlon Community Center (gym), polls open up at 7:00 am and close at 8:00 pm **Masks Are Required.** City of Scanlon has 2 City Council seats open (4 year term) and we have 5 Scanlon residents running for those 2 seats. Good Luck to everyone.

**Winter Parking Restrictions:** During the period from November 1 to March 31 of each year, no person, persons, firm or corporation shall park any motor vehicle on the streets, alleys, boulevard, sidewalks or public grounds within the corporation limits of said City between the hours of midnight and six o'clock a.m. This subdivision does not apply to a motor vehicle parked at an open business establishment between the hours of midnight and 2:00 a.m. unless ordered to be moved at the directions of a peace officer.

**Minnesota State Law:** It is illegal to plow, blow or shovel snow onto a city street, this includes ditches and right of way. It is also illegal to push snow across a city street to an empty lot, adjacent property or ditch.

**Zoning Ordinance Update:** On September 23, 2020, the City Council approved changes to the Zoning Ordinance to include parking of trailers, motorhomes, RV, boats etc. You can get a complete copy of the updated Zoning Ordinance by stopping by the City Clerk's office Monday – Thursday 12-4, or visit City of Scanlon web site to review the Zoning Ordinance.

**Public Nuisance:** On September 23, 2020, the City Council approved changes to the Public Nuisance Ordinance, 1) Compost piles need to be enclosed to prevent debris from blowing into city streets and other properties, 2) Residents that do not have a licensed garbage collector from May 1 to October 1 all bagged trash needs to be brought to a landfill weekly. Other months all bagged trash needs to be brought to landfill bi-weekly.

**Scanlon ½% Sales Tax:** Just a reminder to Scanlon residents, if you purchase something outside of the Scanlon area and are having it delivered to your home in Scanlon, please make sure you remind that Company that Scanlon has a ½% Sale Tax. This Sales Tax goes directly to City of Scanlon to help with our infrastructure and road ways.

**Leash Law:** We have received several calls on animals at large, Scanlon does have a leash law this also includes cats. Please keep your pets safe and if they are outside please have them on a leash.

**Chickens:** City of Cloquet has approved chickens in Cloquet city limits, City of Scanlon has NOT approved chickens in the city. If requested this would have to go to the Planning Commission and then to the City Council for final approval.
