Pursuant to call, and with due notice Mayor, Ron Stigers called to order this meeting of the Scanlon Special City Council at 2:00 p.m. in the Scanlon City Council Chambers on Wednesday, June 17, 2025.

Mike Bubany was present to review the results of a study that was prepared to look at our finances. Some highlights were the following;

- Scanlon has a smaller tax rate
- Scanlon received slightly more than average local government aid
- Scanlon levies quite a bit less than the average of the comparison group of cities
- Scanlon has the lowest City tax rate of all the comparison cities
- Scanlon’s median household income is in the upper half of the comparison group
- Scanlon currently holds a very low level of debt
- Water rates are comparable, and sewer rates are slightly higher than average
- The combined cost of services in Scanlon (taxes, sewer, water) on a typical home is below average

The city was given the model Mike Bubany used and we can put numbers in and out to decide what we may or may want to do with this information.
