

This special meeting was called to approve the 28th and Dewey street project and award the contract. A letter written by Mary Ann Johnson with concerns was reviewed by council members. Discussion on bid amount from Contractors. Kiminski Paving had lowest bid at \$1,338,590.75, Discussion between council and Jeff about Kiminski Paving being the lowest bidder so Jeff recommended we award the contract to them. George spoke about financing and tax impact with a cash contribution and a no cash contribution. One comment from Heather East asking if residents on 28th would be responsible for the cost of the assessment, utilities, and property tax. She also asked if the parking lot would be usable during construction. No other comments from residents. A motion was made by Scott Boedigheimer to award the 28th and Dewey project to Kiminski Paving and approve the project. Ron Stigers seconded the motion. Cody Grashorn abstained due to living in project area. Cody Grashorn wants it on record he lives in the project area and although he is not happy about the costs but feels it is necessary and if it is not done now the price will only go up. All in favor motion carries. Jeff spoke about MSA task order and explained tasks breakdown and costs. Scott made a motion to approve the task order, Cody seconded the motion, all in favor motion carries.
